The Canadian Business Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony and Dinner Celebration hosted on May 12th was among the first in-person events held this year. 600 business leaders, former Companions, including Calin Rovinescu representing the Class of 2021, joined community members and students at the Metro Toronto Convention Centre for the annual signature fundraising event in support of Junior Achievement (JA) Canada. Companions serve as role models to JA students.


